ESPEN guideline: Clinical nutrition in surgery

Guidelines for volume based feeding if applicable. Address the advancement of EN to established goal along with transitions from PN to EN, EN to diet, or hospital to home/alternative care sites. Document instructions for water flushes, including the solution to be used (eg, purified water), volume, frequency, and timing, as well as the volume ...

ASPEN defines the adult population to be above the age of 18 years old, the pediatric population to be between 28 days and 18 years old, and the neonatal population to be younger than 28 days. Pathophysiology of Refeeding Syndrome

ASPEN Criteria Published National Guidelines (2011) - the evidenced based criteria developed by the Academy and ASPEN, to identify and diagnose malnutrition: 6 Clinical Characteristics - Insufficient food intake compared with nutrition requirements - Weight loss over time - Loss of muscle mass - Loss of subcutaneous fat mass

MALNUTRITION

ASPEN Guidelines 2016 Protein: 1.2 - 2.0 g/kg actual BW per day Albumin, pre-albumin, transferrin and CRP should not be used as indicators of protein status. (Section A4) Calories: Published predicative equation or simplistic weight-based 25 - 30 kcals/ kg using dry BW or UBW in critically ill pts. (Section A3a & A3b). Initiation of EN:
