Guided reading offers students meaningful instruction that is intentional. Texts are at a student's instructional level of reading {ie: not easy, not too hard, just a little challenge}.

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Guided Reading Tools - I Love 1st Grade

Guided reading is all about practice, so have students whisper read (or silently read - in late first grade and second grade) all of the words on their own. That said, some students in Kindergarten or early first grade may need more support than the book introduction in order to be successful with the text.

Small Group Guided Reading Structure for Less Stress

First Grade Reading: Literature Standards. RL.1.1. Ask and answer questions about key details in a text. RL.1.2. Steps in the guided reading process: Gather information about the readers to identify emphases. Select and analyze texts to use. Introduce the text. Observe children as they read the text individually (support if needed). Invite children to discuss the meaning of the text. Make one or two teaching points.
