Snip the corners, then turn the cushion cover right-side-out. Cut the corners of your panels off as close to the stitching as you can. Next, turn the fabric right-side-out through the open zipper. Use a knitting needle or a chopstick to push the corners out further, if needed.

How to make an envelope cushion. 1. Start by measuring the cushion pad itself. For the width of the cushion add 3cm for a seam allowance, so 48cm for a 45cm cushion. For the length, double this width and add 10cm to allow for the envelope overlap, so 106cm. 2.

Measure out the first piece of fabric, adding a half an inch to each side for seam allowance. For a 40 inch by 15 inch bench, you will need to measure out a piece of fabric 41 inches by 16 inches. The two pieces for the bottom or back of the cushion will overlap each other. This is called an

How to make a cushion cover To make a 40cm cushion you need to cut the fabric so there's a cm on each side for the hem and an extra 0.5cm on the edge for the zip. This means each piece needs to be 42cm x 42.5cm. Place the two pieces of fabric right sides together.

How to make a cushion cover with a zip - VIDEO

Adding Filling and Closing Cushion. Step 1. Use silk film and cover the cushion on all sides. This is done so that it will be easier to insert the cushion into the cover later on. Step 2. Using a vacuum, compress the pillow insert until it's reduced into half its former size. Step 3. Insert the cushion with the vacuum still on.

Easy DIY Outdoor Cushion Covers

To connect your long side panel strip and make one big continuous loop around the edge of your cushion, fold the panel in half (with the right sides facing each other), and sew 1/2" from the edge to connect the ends.
