For quotations that extend to more than four lines of verse or prose, place quotations in a free-standing block of text and omit quotation marks. Start the quotation on a new line, with the entire quote indented one inch from the left margin; maintain double-spacing.

HOW TO USE QUOTES IN A RESEARCH PAPER

To indicate short quotations (four typed lines or fewer of prose or three lines of verse) in your text, enclose the quotation within double quotation marks. Provide the author and specific page number (in the case of verse, provide line numbers) in the in-text citation, and include a complete reference on the Works Cited page.

When paraphrasing or summarizing a web page, the citation should include the author last name and date listed on the web page or at the bottom of the website.. If you are using a quote, you will also need to include the page number.If there are no page numbers, include the most direct location of the quote, such as a section title and/or a paragraph number.

Also known as quote marks, quotes, and speech marks. In the U.S., periods and commas always go inside the quotation marks. In the U.K., periods and commas go inside the quotation marks only for a complete quoted sentence; otherwise, they go outside. In all varieties of English, semicolons and colons go outside the quotation marks.

Guidelines for Using Quotation Marks Effectively

The quote within the quote. Do unto others as you would have them do unto you, is enclosed in single quotation marks. (The British convention is the opposite; the main quote would use single quotation marks and the quote within the quote would use double quotation marks.)

If the quoted words are a question, put the question mark inside the quotation marks. If the entire sentence is a question, put the question mark outside the quotation marks.
