Listen for Key Words. What words does the speaker emphasize? Usually the speaker will let you know by stressing the main point: " Let's talk about the TIME we will meet tomorrow.... " The stressed word " time " signals that the time of tomorrow's appointment is the main point, as does the marker " Let's talk about— ".

For instance, a pedagogical task designed to teach EFL students to give personal information in a job interview might involve exercises in comprehension of wh-questions, listening to extracts of job interviews, analyzing the grammar and discourse of job interviews, modeling an interview (teacher and one student), role-playing a simulated interview (students in pairs) and understanding crosscultural rules of etiquette in a job interview.
